The new and revised 2011 ICD-9-CM code set will take effect October 1, 2010, with multiple additions, revisions, and deletions that may impact accurate home care coding and reimbursement. This program will review the *pertinent* code changes that take effect October 1, 2010. Case study application of new and revised codes will provide examples of the accurate use of the newly released 2011 codes in the home health setting. Clarification of changes, deletions and application of the new codes will prepare your home care staff precise code assignment that ensures accurate agency reimbursement.
