3. Use of engineering and work practice controls to reduce the opportunity for patient and healthcare worker contact with potentially infectious material for bloodborne pathogens.
4. Selection and use of barriers and/or personal protective equipment for preventing patient and healthcare worker contact with potentially infectious material.
5. Creation and maintenance of a safe environment for patient care through application of infection control principles and practices for cleaning, disinfection, and sterilization.
6. Prevention and management of infectious or communicable diseases in healthcare workers.
